Said appointment is in all things approved.  
 Coming on to be heard, the repairing of the  
 City Dam, it appearing that said Dam was  
 in danger of being destroyed by washing, it is  
 ordered by the City Council that A. M. Druman  
 be and he is hereby authorized to enter into  
 contract with some person or corporations for  
 the repairing of said Dam for such terms and  
 prices and in such manner or condition of  
 repairs as he may see proper to have done.

The act of C. M. McComico as Marshall  
 for month of Sept 1902 for \$75.00 be and the  
 same is hereby approved and Secty ordered to  
 issue to said C. M. McComico Script for said  
 amount,

The account of Lufkin Electric Light Plant for  
 \$22.00 approved and Secty ordered to issue  
 Script for same

It is ordered that J. L. Moffitt be and he is  
 hereby required to pay the sum of \$5.00 per month for  
 use of water in the Steam Laundry and that Cook Bros  
 be required to pay the sum of \$5.00 per month and Eastern Texas  
 Rail Road Co required to pay five dollars per  
 month and Lufkin Foundry Machine Co be required to  
 pay the sum of Ten Dollars per month for use
