It is ordered by the City Council of the City of Lufkin that Dixan J. Abney City Attorney, be and is hereby authorized if required to file suit against W. H. Doggett City Assessor & Collector of the City of Lufkin on his official Bonds & his bondsmen for failure of duty of said officer in the assessing & collecting of the taxes due to the City of Lufkin for any previous years including the year 1902.
