Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lufkin that if any person shall knowingly drive or cause to be driven any vehicle of any character whatever over or upon any fire or water hose in the city of Lufkin or who shall in any way injure or obstruct any such hose, shall be fined not less than (\$25⁰⁰) Twenty five Dollars, nor more than
