

Lufkin Texas May 5th 1891

Call session of the board of Aldermen for the Corporation of the town of Lufkin held in the Office of the Mayor, J. M. Smith Mayor presiding, J. I. Wautzack, J. H. West, J. M. Thompson, J. P. West. Alderman ^{present} was duly installed by Mayor Smith Business then being in order. It was ordered by the board of Aldermen of the town of Lufkin that W. M. Jones be allowed to collect revenues from the State & County for prisoners occupying the town prisons & allowing him \$5 Cents per day for feeding prisoners. Further ordered that the Marshal W. M. Jones be authorized to buy one Cows of Overhuns as the Wilsons Debt & to pay therefor Sixty Dollars.

Ordered by the Town Council of the town of Lufkin that the Mayor & Aldermen of said town be & they are each allowed the sum of Ten Dollars per day for each day they may be in attendance upon their regular meetings once in each month.
