It is ordered by the City Council that the Lupine Electric Light Plant place two (2) additional Arc Lights on public square as follows, 1 at Corner of M. H. Bonner and Stone St at Corner of W. M. Shuman & Stone,

The City Secretary was instructed by City Council to notify City Treasurer M. H. Bonner by mail to resign the office of City Treasurer, owing to the fact he has left the City & no one in charge of said office, motion made by A. H. Townsend Second by Shaver, all voted aye.

May 5th 1903 Continued -

The following Ordinance was passed by unanimous Vote of those present:

It is ordained by the City Council of the City of Lupton that J. J. Richardson, Thos. W. Hamason and A. D. Collins be ^{and} ~~are~~ hereby appointed to constitute a board of Equalization for the City of Lupton for the year of 1903. ^{and} said boards shall meet on June 15th 1903 to transact such business as may come before them as such boards -

C. N. Hamason and H. D. Price were instructed by the City Council to purchase for the Lupton Fire Department, a Fire Alarm Bell.
