Report of Street Commissioners read and approved showing balance due Street Overseer \$67.⁰⁸ said amount to be paid out of 1st money rec'd from Street Tax,

Comd Masters report read & approved showing \$26.⁵⁰ rec'd & \$26.⁵⁰ disbursed.

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On Motion of Alderman Johnson, & seconded by
 Largest, it was carried that the
 fines of \$3⁰⁰ each assessed against Alderman
 Lowbrud & Shearer for failure to attend
 Council meeting July 7th be remitted.

Building and Constructing Supervisors report
 that there was nothing doing in their
 line during the month of July, and have
 nothing to report.

Chairman of Finance Committee reports
 that at present he is acting for the
 County on Finance Committee and will
 take up the City's work soon as
 his job with County is completed.
 Council granted him until next
 regular meeting to report.

All members of Council discuss Land
 Titles, statute of limitation, and various
