

Lufkin Texas Sept 8th 1903.

The City Council of the City of Lufkin met in pursuance to the call of Mayor Denman - the following present and acting -

After Council was called to order
Dix F. Abney was appointed City
Pro-Tem, the following Ordinance
was passed by unanimous vote
of their present.

An Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lufkin that whereas there exists a public necessity to the inhabitants of the City of Lufkin that the City should purchase an additional body of land now owned by A. J. Vinson and Ella Vinson adjoining the lands of the City reservoir, in order to have more water sheds and to protect the reservoir of water now in use, from the drainage of other lands into said city reservoir that are unwholesome and unclean, and the City having no available money to purchase said lands and whereas it will take two thousand dollars to purchase said lands and put them in proper repair for shed for said reservoir and its protection, therefore an election is hereby ordered to be held within the incorporate limits of the City of Lufkin on the 3rd day of Oct., 1903, at the Hall of the City Council in Cotton square in the City of Lufkin, Angelina County, Texas, to determine whether or not the City Council of the City of Lufkin shall be authorized to issue bonds to the amount of \$2,000.00 to draw interest at the rate of 5 per cent per annum and to run 20 years with right on part of City to redeem the same at expiration of ten years from their date.
