constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. The Minutes of all meetings held during the month of July were read and approved.
2. A resolution was introduced by Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by Jas. A. Abney and carried by unanimous vote of the commission, commending and rewarding Henry Box for noticing and reporting two men who were attempting to climb up on the City Water Tower.
3. Copy of this resolution is filed in permanent with minutes.
4. Mr. Kelley reported a request for a further extension of 100 feet of the sanitary drain box off of South Raguet and Jefferson streets through the Harrell property.
5. Motion by Cary C. Trevathan, seconded by Jas. A. Abney was carried approving the extension and granting the City Manager authority for employing the men and purchase of material needed for making the extension, provided the Lufkin Foundry & Machine Company would pay half the cost.
6. Motion was made by Jas. A. Abney, second by B.F. Milligan authorizing the employment of men and purchase of material needed for repairing spillway at the City Lake and also for employing a helper at the City park.
7. The motion was carried, all commissioners voting yea.
8. Mr. Kelley reported requests for paving One Block on Lufkin Avenue East from Fourth Street and motion was made by Cary C. Trevathan, second by R.E. Melvin and duly carried authorizing the City Manager to make necessary arrangements to pave this block.
9. Resolution was introduced by C. C. Trevathan, Second by Jas A. Abney and carried by unanimous vote accepting from Reynolds & Sutton the paving of Units No. 16 - 17 - 18 - 21 - 33 & 34 of the Street Paving project.
10. Resolution as adopted is filed along with the minutes in permanent record.

There being nothing further to come before the meeting it was regularly adjourned.
