- The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting was to consider the proposed budget of the City for fiscal year of 1942-1943. After a thorough consideration and discussion, the meeting was recessed to July 7th, 1942 at 7:30 P. M.
- Q. Pursuant to the above recess order, the meeting of July 6th was resumed immediately after the conclusion of the Regular Monthly meeting of the commission on July 7, 1942 in the regular meeting place. The remainder of the budget was reviewed. Some changes were recommended and this meeting was recessed to July 17, 1942 at 9:00 A. M. for further consideration of budget.
- 3. Pursuant to recess order of July 7th, 1942, the meeting of July 6, 1942 was resumed with Commissioners R. E. Melvin and C. C. Trevathan absent. Among other suggested changes and additions to the budget, the sum of \$1,500.00 was set up to carry out malaria Control Project if and when W. P. A. approves and issues necessary work orders.

Upon motion of Jas. A. Abney, seconded by B. F. Milligan, the Public Hearing on the Budget was set for Thursday, August 13th, 1942 at 7:30 P. M. Notice was ordered to be published to this effect.

Upon recommendation of Mr. Kelley, he was authorized to employ a secretary during the vacation of Miss Swan. Also, Mr. Kelley was authorized to employ extra help for Mr. Russell in order that increased laboratory work be taken care of during summer.

Upon Motion of Jas. A. Abney, Seconded by B. F. Milligan the following resolution was introduced for passage:
