1. The minutes of all meeting during the month of July were
read, approved, and adopted. Mrs. Martin, Supervisor of W.P.A
Housekeeping Aid appeared in the interest of appropriation by
the City of funds to support the project. This matter was carried
over for consideration along with the budget.

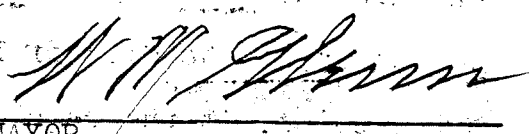
2. The accounts for the month of June, amounting *to* \$3793.58
were read and approved for payment. Mr. Kelley reported two or three
sanitary sewer projects involving some 1500 feet of extensions and
it was decided to investigate the possibility of property owners
securing equipment for this purpose. Voucher #3, dated 6/1/42,
in the amount of \$3943.03 and Voucher #4, dated 7/1/42, in the
amount of \$2632.45, in favor of Reynolds & Sutton were presented
and approved for payment upon recommendation of Mr. Kelley.

3. The matter of giving Hollis Perry credit on his paving for
curb & gutter in place was postponed pending investigation.

A Upon motion of B. F. Milligan, seconded by Jas. A. Abeny, it was decided to carry J.A. Jenkins on the payroll for not more than 30 days from this date pending recovery from sickness.

There being nothing further to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and seconded, adjourned.
