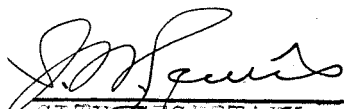
being present, and the following absent: NONE,
constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

1. Bills for December 1944, amounting to \$4,040.83, was presented for approval, and on motion of Arthur Temple, Jr., second by D. M. Thrash, and all members voting yes, were approved for payment.
2. Mr. A. S. Croom made complaint about unsanitary condition near him, on premises of John Mason. After thorough discussion and without formal action, City Manager and City Attorney were instructed to handle the matter in the regular manner.
3. Mayor Glenn reported that he had received a letter from the State Highway Engineer, with Minute that was passed by the State Highway Commission on December 12, 1944, providing for Highway 59 Loop through Lufkin, to cross the T. & N. O. Railroad just North of the Round House, which is not in accord with resolution passed by the City Commission on December 8, 1944.
4. Mayor Glenn had written State Highway Engineer, asking that the thoroughfare be located as requested by the City Commission on December 8, 1944.

No further business was presented, so the meeting adjourned.
