By unanimous vote of all present an ordinance was passed, making it unlawfull for any person, firm or Corporation engaged in the transaction of any business within the incorporate limits of the City of Lepkin Tex to deposit any paper, paper boxes, wood, wooden boxes, bags, fruits, Vegetables, sweeping, ~~or~~ or any such substance on the premises owned or occupied by them, or on the sidewalks in front, on the side, or ^{to the} rear of any such premises, or on any public street or

alley in said City, but they shall deposit, all such substance above enumerated in a suitable ^{at least} Box or Barrel which shall be emptied ^{at least} once each day in a place designated by the City Marshall of said City, Any one violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than five dollars nor more than Ten dollars, All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed (approved July 17/05)

This foregoing ordinance was passed by unanimous vote of all present,

Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Lufkin that all persons who ~~on~~ ~~may~~ ~~hereafter~~ have heretofore acquired or may hereafter acquire an occupation license to carry on any occupation taxable by law under the municipal Government of the City of Lufkin, in the event of the sale of such license by the Licensor the City hereby is hereby authorized to make a transfer of said license to such purchaser and to enter the same on the minutes of the City Council, provided

Be it ordained by the City Council
 of the City of Lupton Texas that it
 shall be unlawfull for any person
 firm or corporation to
 burn any substance of volatile
 character within the first limits
 of the City of Lupton, unless said
 substance is burned in a
 stove, furnace or fire place
 inside of a house in
 said first limits, any one
 violating the provisions of this
 ordinance shall be deemed
 guilty of a misdemeanor and
 upon conviction thereof
 shall be fined in any sum
 not less than (\$500) five dollars and
 not more than ten dollars
 all ordinances or parts of
 ordinances in conflict herewith
 are hereby repealed
