

MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD ON JUNE 29th, 1948, 7:30 O'Clock P.M.

On this the 29th day of June, A. D. 1948, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, met in a called meeting in the Regular Meeting Place in said City with the following members, thereof-to-wit:

ABSENT: C. C. Sinclair, Commissioner Ward No. 3, (Out of City.)

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The following proceedings were had, to-wit:

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1. The City Budget for the fiscal year 1948-49 was discussed, and the ways and means of financing same came up for discussion.

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2. A Motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash that an Amendment to existing Ordinance in regard to Water Rates be amended as follows: The Minimum Water Rates for Residence inside of City be raised from the \$2.00 to \$2.75 for 5,000 Gallons, or less and the other brackets to be figured accordingly, and Residence Outside of City be raised to \$3.25 for 5,000 Gallons, or less, and the present Commercial Rate to be increased 50%, making the minimum of 3,000 gallons or less \$2.25 and the other brackets to be figured at 50% increase. same to become effective as of August 1st, 1948, Billing. Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE". "NOES" NONE.

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3 Mr. Early discussed the City's Finances, and requested that City be authorized to borrow \$25,000.00 from local bank to meet current expenses. A Motion was made by D. M. Thrash and Seconded by L. C. Martin that City be authorized by resolution to borrow the \$25,000.00 to meet Current Expenses. The Mayor put the motion to a vote, all voted "AYE"., "Noes", None.

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4 A motion was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by G. W. Roland, that a per mit ^{see} legal Limits to Gover of \$25.00 be charged for moving houses on or across City Streets? The Mayor put the motion to a vote. All voted "Aye" "Noes" None.

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5 A motion was made by D. M. Thrash and seconded by L. C. Martin that Zone Change be granted C. P. Sumners and Robt. Denum, Jr., on lots 1, 2, 13 and 14 Block 1, High Scholl Hts. Addition to City of Lufkin, From District "A" to District "B". Mayor put motion to a vote. All voted "AYE" , "NOES" none.

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The City Budget was checked by Departments, with a change in Salary in Police Department of City Judge from \$175.00 to \$200.00 per month, and The Water Department Meter Men 's Salary to go on full time in General Department Water & Sewer. A Motion Was made by L. C. Martin and seconded by D. M. Thrash that Budget be accepted and approved with the above changes. ^{TENTATIVELY -} Mayor put motion to a vote, all voted "AYE", "NOES" None.

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2 It was agreed to make a charge of \$2.00 to the person requesting a zone change, to pay for the Legal Advertising. 019 PERMIT-TAXI

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8 Mr. Early discussed with the council a location for Dump Grounds for Trash & Garbage, (Driscoll Property.)

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, and on motion duly made and carried it adjourned.
