7:30 P. M.

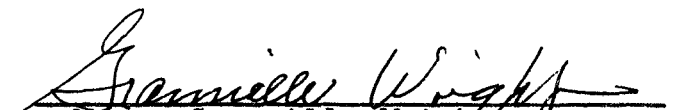

constituting a quorum when the following business was transacted:

- 1 Minutes of meeting of August 21, 1951, approved on motion of Commissioner Snell, seconded by Commissioner Stegall.
2. Mayor Wright was requested to investigate a request submitted by a representation from Scarbrough Street that Scarbrough Street be opened to Abney Street, and that a culvert be placed on Birch Street at Sayers, between Sayers and Scarbrough.
- 3 The Schuller Addition was accepted by the Commission for dedication, motion Commissioner Stegall, second Commissioner Snell.
- 4 Commissioner Snell proposed that the City be sprayed again, conditioned on a continuance of hot, dry weather, second by Commissioner Stegall.
- 5 Commissioner Stegall moved that the City pave Pershing Street through the City Park, second by Commissioner Treadwell.
- 6 Mr. Steenson was instructed to buy a Motorola Radio , on terms, for the Police Department. Mr. Steenson was further instructed to place an order for an additional 500 water meters.
