the following business was transacted:

- 1 Minutes of the October 2nd meeting were approved.
- 2 September bills were approved, motion by Commissioner Zeagler, seconded by Commissioner Treadwell.
- 3 The purchase of a 90 ft. aluminum tower for the radio antenna for a cost of \$288.00, and an adapter permitting the operation of the radio on two frequencies, cost approximately \$27.50, was approved.
- 4 The Texas Highway plans on proposed highway 69 were examined, but acceptance of the plans was deferred.
- 5 The Commission recommended further investigation on a proposed extension of Davis Street to North First Street.
