D. C. Hall-----City Secretary

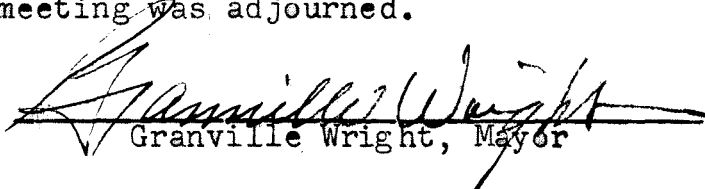
and L. B. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward 3, being absent.
A quorum being present, the following business was transacted:

1 The Pastor and some members of the Central Baptist
Church appeared before the Commission in behalf of a Zone
change. The application for said change had not been received
from the Zoning Board, therefore, there was no action taken.

2 The Commission discussed at length, a tax matter pre-
sented unofficially by W. F. Deal. No action taken.

3 Monthly bills for October were submitted to the Council
for their study and approval. Commission Stegall made motion
that all bills be paid, seconded by Commissioner Nerren. All
voted Aye.
