- 1. The minutes of regular meeting of the Commission held August 18, 1953, at 7:30 P.M. were read and approved.
- 2. Commission granted permission to Rosa Lee Matterson to operate Beauty Parlor at 111 Forest Park Blvd. on a temporary basis provided she could obtain written permission from adjacent property owners. Mrs. Matterson to be the only operator. Motion by Gipson, Seconded by Nerren, all voted Aye.
- 3. Mr. John Redditt, and citizens residing on the Harmony Hill Road discussed with the Commission the construction of 4" and 6" water line to serve them extending from the Two Point area. The material necessary to extend the 6" line to the City limits to be amortised over a period of 5 years, and by Nerren, all voting Aye.
  - 4. Commission passed on first and final reading the following Zone changes:

Granville Wright from "A" to "M" district on a tract of 26 acres of land located on North side of Frank Street extension of Highway 94, on the J. A. Bonton League.

Otis L. Allen from "B" to "F" district on lots #1, Block #3, North Lufkin Addexcept the North 42 feet thereof. Motion by Gipson, seconded by Nerren, all voting Aye.

- 5. Commission instructed City Attorney to prepare ordinance against the blocking or interferring with fire fighting equipment in any manner. Said ordinance to impose fine for violations.
- 6. On motion by Gipson, Seconded by Nerren, all voting Aye, Commission voted against hiring an outside appraiser to set values on City property for tax purposes.
- 7. Called meeting of Citizens Committee to meet for purpose of discussing the construction of New Fire Station on Ellis Ave. Commission also voted against the construction of said fire station by any other means except by funds of the City of Lufkin.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
