1. The minutes of special meeting held August 24, 1953 at 7:30 P.M. were read and approved.

2. City Attorney Brazil reported to the Commission that the City of Lufkin had an ordinance regulating the Blocking or interfering with the City Fire department in their line of duty. City Attorney was instructed to prepare copies of said Ordinance and furnish same to the Police and Fire Departments.

3. Mr. B.M.E. Smith, Manager of the Land O'Pines Dairy discussed with the Commission the processing tax paid to the City by Land O'Pines. Mr. Smith contended that at the Dairy was paying a high City Tax, they should not be taxed on milk processed. The Commission agreed to consider the matter and it would be taken up at next meeting.

4. The Commission O.K.'d payment of \$15,418.50 for new fire truck recently received from the Seagrave Corporation and passed and approved by the State Fire Insurance Commission.

5. Passed for publication the following Zone change applications:

John Mason from A to H district on tract and parcel of land, located in the City of Lufkin between Highway 59, Nesbit, Lock and Paul Ave.

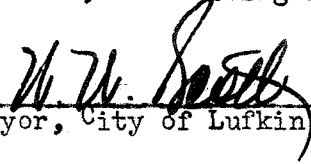
James E. Mattox from E to F district on Lots No. 1 & 2 in Block No. 1 of Lofton Springs Addition.

L.P. Nesbitt, from A to F district on parcel of land being 86' on the S side of Paul Ave and extending 150' on E side of Timberland Dr.

6. Commission voted to send Police Chief George Powell to international association of Police Chiefs at Detroit, Mich. He to be allowed the sum of \$100.00 plus transportation.

7. The Commission instructed City Attorney Brazil to prepare an Ordinance requiring Doors & locks to be removed from Old refrigerators and ice boxes when exposed and not in use, within the City Limits of Lufkin.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
