

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD SEPT. 29, 1953 at 7:30 P.M.

On this the 29th day of Sept. A.D., 1953, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in special session at its regular meeting place in said City with the following members thereof being present:

All members thereof being present, the following business was transacted.

1. The minutes of regular meeting held Sept. 15, 1953 were read and approved.
2. A group of citizens residing on South Warren Street were informed that their portion of cost of water line extension would be approximately \$1250.00.
3. Approved final passage of the following Zone Changes:
James Mattox from E to F District on Lots numbers 1 & 2 in Block 1 of the Lofton Springs Addition to City of Lufkin.
John Mason from A to H district on tract of land described by metes & bounds, located between highway 59 bypass, Nesbit, Lock and Paul Ave.
L. P. Nesbitt from A to F district on parcel of land being 86' on South side of Paul Ave and extending 150' on East side of timberland drive.
4. Passed for publication zone change request of C. S. Knighton from A to F district on North 1/3 of Lot #5A Block #20 North Lufkin Addition, being 118' on Cotton Belt Street and 100' on North Ave.
5. Passed a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a lease for 99 years to The Texas National Guard Armory Board, on a tract of land containing 4.62 acres being a portion of a 26.4 acre tract owned by the City of Lufkin.
6. Authorized the Mayor to transmit letter to the Texas National Guard Armory Board, pledging that utilities would be extended to a distance of within 5 ft. of Armory building to be erected on site granted them.
7. Passed on first and final reading an ordinance prohibiting parking on certain streets at the intersection of Timberland Drive and Kurth Drive,
8. Requested the City Attorney to prepare a map of strip zoning on Timberland Drive, Kurth Drive, Chestnut and East Denman Avenue.
9. Voted to place Block numbers on proposed street signs to be erected by the City.
10. The Commission requested City Manager to secure detailed cost of street signs from Mackay Foundry of Lufkin and also cost of Pipe from Lufkin Foundry & Machine Co.
11. Commission voted unanimously to send City Manager Joe McClendon, to meeting of Texas League of Municipalities at Beaumont, Texas, October 25, 26 & 27.
12. Set week of Oct. 5, 1953 for Drive to Pick up all Stray Dogs in City limits.
13. Instructed City Attorney, City Judge and Chief of Police to organize a Traffic Bureau for the Police Department.
14. Commission voted to pay Paul Scroggins the sum of \$265.00 to reimburse him for expenses while attending Police school.
15. Commission instructed City Manager to investigate the possibility of renting one of the adjacent building to the City Hall for possibility of moving Police Department or securing more room for the City Hall Offices.
16. Commission turned down application of Lufkin Transit Co. for rate increase till next meeting, and they to furnish a complete financial statement.

There being no further business, the meeting duly adjourned.
