1 The minutes of the regular meeting held March 3, 1953, were read and approved by the commission.


2 Mr. James Butler appeared before the Commission, and outlined program on the Civil Air Patrol and asked that the Commission grant permission to the Civil Air Patrol to erect building in one of the City Parks. Said building to be used by the C. A. P. for Radio Receiving and Transmitting Station, School, and other activities. The Commission deferred action for further study.

3 Mr. Eddie McFarland presented Zone change application from "A" to "H" district, covering lots 10, 11, and 12 in block No. 2 of the W. H. Everitt Addition to the City of Lufkin, and the North 10 ft of an abandoned alley abutting the South end of said lots. Except a portion of Lot No. 10, which was conveyed to the City of Lufkin for Right-of-Way purposes. This application was passed unanimously on first reading for publication and final hearing on April 7, 1953.


4 The Commission discussed and agreed to amend the ordinance of the City of Lufkin, pertaining to dogs, and to enforce said ordinance.

5 The Commission voted to pay all bills for the month of February as submitted.

There being no further business, the Commission duly adjourned.
