The Minutes of Special Meeting held April 28, 1953 were read and approved.

1 Zone Change Application of J. E. Walker and A. M. Walker from "B" to "G" district on 17.66 acres of land, being a portion of the Walker Addition to the City of Lufkin was approved by the Commission. Motion - Nerren, Second - Gipson - all voting "Yea". The Commission also voted to participate in the paving of Martha Street.- For the sum of 20% of the cost - East Texas Theaters, Inc to pay 80%. Motion - Gipson, Second - Nerren, all voting "Yea".

2 The Commission approved Zone Change Application of E. L. Berry and Abe French for change from "A" to "H" district covering lots -1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 in block 3 of the J. S. Moore Addition to the City of Lufkin. Motion - Collins, Second - Gipson - all voting "Yea"

3 The Commission received and approved for publication Zone Change Application of J. A. Bryan, From "F" to "H" district, covering lot 2, block 2 in the Atkinson Drive Addition to the City of Lufkin. Motion - Nerren, Second - Gipson - all voting "Yea".

4 The Commission approved contract of City Attorney C. E. Brazil, for the collection of Delinquent Taxes for the City of Lufkin. Motion - Gipson, Second - Collins - all voting "Yea".

5 The Commission passed ordinance, making it mandatory that all residents be charged for garbage pick-up and disposal. Motion - Collins, second - Nerren - all voting "Yea".

There being no further business the meeting duly adjourned.
