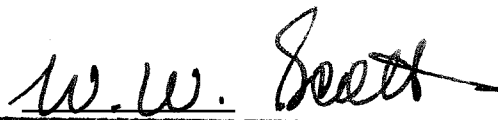
A quorum being present, the following business was transacted.

1 The Minutes of Regular Meeting held May 19, 1953 and Minutes of called Meeting held May 22, 1953 were read by the Mayor and approved by the Commission.

2 A group of citizens residing in the Two Point area were present and with Kenneth Barfield as spokesman, presented a petition to the Commission with 47 signatures, requesting that they be given sewer service in their area. The Council instructed the City Manager to prepare estimate of sewer connection to this area and the request would be discussed at the next Council Meeting.

3 Mr. Gus Boesch & Mr. Hermann Brown appeared before the Council to discuss the possibility of the installation of Public Scales. Should a satisfactory site be obtained. After much discussion, the matter was deferred until more information could be secured.
