On this the 30th day of June, A.D., 1953, The City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in Special Session at the regular meeting place in said City with the following members thereof present:

The minutes of called meeting of the City Commission held June 23, 1953, at 7:30. P.M. were read and approved by the Commission.

I Mr. Castleberry appeared before the Commission in regard to odor and flies caused by chicken processing plant operated by Mrs. Thompson on North Angelina Street. After much discussion the Commission agreed to instruct City Health Officer to have Mrs. Thompson spray premises to control flies and to keep same clean and in samitary condition to meet with City Ordinances.

The Commission received one bid on house and lot owned by the City of Lufkin, located at 1419 North First Street. This Bid was from Mrs. S. S. Dublin in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars, (\$2000.00). On Motion of Com. Nerren and seconded by Mr. Gipson, the Commission unamiously rejected this Bid.

The Commission discussed at length the appointment of a Municipal Development Commission. The Commission agreed upon a ten men Commission headed by George H. Henderson, and composed of the following members: Bill Spitlek, Lloyd Moore, Wilbur Kent, Sumner Williams, W. R. Beaumier, Robt. O. Moore, Jewel Hudgens, Leland Petty and J. C. Holliday.

There being no further business, the Commission duly adjourned.
