1. The minutes of the regular meeting held July 21, 1953 were read and approved.

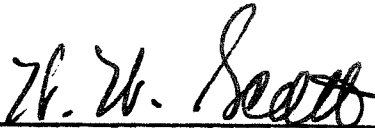
2. The Commission instructed City Manager, McClendon to investigate parking conditions at the County Hospital and to work out plan with them to use vacant lot belonging to Hospital, in order to relieve conjection on Bynum Street.

3. The Commission discussed the condition of various streets in the City, and it was decided to repair streets as fas as possible out of the \$15,000.00 previously set aside for this purposes.

4. On motion of Mr. Gipson & seconded by Mr. Nerren, all voting "Aye," the Commission instructed City Manager to proceed with repairs on City Police cars.

5. The Commission discussed at length the straightening and widening of Lufkin Avenue to Timberland Drive.
