- l. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
- 2. Minutes of the regular meeting of October 18th were read and approved.
- 3. Foster Myers came before the Commission with his sponsors, W. H. Moore, Tommie Garrison, and R. F. Myers, in the interest of the "drag strip" at the Municipal Airport. On account of the absence of two members of the commission, final action on the application for permission to use a portion of the Municipal Airport land was postponed until the next regular meeting of the Commission.
