

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD NOVEMBER 1st,
1955, AT 7:30 P.M.

On this the 1st day of November, A. D. 1955,
the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened
in regular session, in the regular meeting place in

Ward 4, constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
2. Minutes of the regular meeting of October 18th were read and approved.
3. Foster Myers came before the Commission with his sponsors, W. H. Moore, Tommie Garrison, and R. F. Myers, in the interest of the "drag strip" at the Municipal Airport. On account of the absence of two members of the commission, final action on the application for permission to use a portion of the Municipal Airport land was postponed until the next regular meeting of the Commission.
4. Cotten Harrell came before the Commission and presented a map showing the proposed exchange of land adjoining the Municipal Airport. The map and plat was left with the Commission for further study and consideration.
5. An ordinance regulating the speed limit as requested by the State Highway Department on Southwood Drive or the Old Diboll Highway, was passed on first reading.
6. Zone application of Thelma McLain to change the zone from "B" to "F" on Lot No. 1, Block No. 48 of the original Townsite was ordered published for hearing to be held on December 6, 1955.

7. There being no further business to be considered, motion was made by Commissioner Collins and seconded by Commissioner Nerren to recess the meeting until November 2nd, 1955, the motion carried and the meeting was recessed until 5:00 O'clock P.M., November 2, 1955.
