**An Ordinance.**

Be it ordained by the city  
council of the city of Lufkin,  
that if any person shall discharge  
any fire cracker, roman candle,  
sky rocket or torpedoes, or other  
fire works or fire toys in any  
street, avenue, alley, square or  
in any other public place within  
the corporate limits of the city of  
Lufkin he shall be deemed guilty  
of a misdemeanor and upon con-  
viction thereof shall be fined in  
any sum not less than five dollars  
and not more than twenty-five  
dollars. All laws or parts of laws  
in conflict herewith are hereby  
repealed.
