

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION

Commissioner, Ward 1 _____, constituting a quorum when the follow-
ing business was transacted:

1. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mayor Woodrow W. Scott.
2. The minutes of the regular meeting held December 20, 1955, were read and approved.
3. Hiram Rolston appeared in behalf of O. B. Rice and proposed to salvage all brass, scrap iron and materials at the City Dump Ground and stated that his client would pay the City 15% of the sale price of all salvaged materials. The City Commission agreed to accept his proposition and he was instructed to get with the City Attorney and prepare the proper contract.
4. An ordinance was passed on first reading providing for the construction and maintenance by the State Highway Department of F.M. Road No. 2251 from U. S. Highway 69 North to the City Limits.
5. Publication was ordered on zone change applications of Ben Vaughn and Charlie Strahan, such applications to be heard on the first Tuesday in February, 1956.
6. There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
