On Motion of C. A. Burke & see by
C. N. Humason that the following
orders, ordering elections for stock law
be passed.

Be it ordered by the city council of the city of Lufkin that an
election be held on the 1st, Tuesday in April 1907 being the 2nd, day
of said month, at the fire station in said city for the purpose of de-
termining whether or not cows, goats, horses, mules, jacks, jennets and
sheep shall be allowed to run at large within the incorporated limits
of the said city of Lufkin.

Said election shall be held at the fire station in said city
and we hereby appoint H. D. Weaver as presiding judge of said election.

The ballots to be used in said election shall be printed under
the supervision of the city secretary of the city of Lufkin as in
other cases made and provided; there shall be two kinds of tickets
reading as follows: "For the stock law" -- "Against the stock law" --

Those who wish to vote for the stock law being put into force
in the city shall use the ticket reading "For the stock law"; Those
wishing to vote against the stock law being put into force in the
city shall use the tickets reading "Against the stock law".

Said election shall be held according to the laws of the city
and State governing all elections.
