Election Order

Whereas, the city council of the city of Lufkin, Texas deems it advisable to issue bonds of said city for the purpose hereinafter mentioned. Therefore it is hereby ordered by the city council of the said city, that an election be held on the 24th day of October A.D. 1907, at which election the following proposition shall be submitted: Shall the city council of the city of Lufkin, Texas, be authorized to issue ^{The} bonds of said city in the sum of Five
Thousand Dollars, payable in TWENTY (20) years after date, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum, payable annually and to levy a tax sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and create a sinking fund sufficient to redeem them at maturity, (to procure funds with which to pay for the boring of an artesian well on the city reservoir property for the purpose of furnishing water to the citizens of the city of Lufkin.) Said election shall be held at the city fire station in said city, and the following named person is hereby appointed manager of said election.

J. M. Smith

Said election shall be held under the provisions of Chapter No. 149, Acts of the 26th, Legislature Laws 1899, and only qualified voters who are property tax payers of said city, shall be allowed to vote, and all voters desiring to support the proposition to issue bonds, shall have printed on their ballots the words, "For issuance of bonds", and those opposed shall have printed on their ballots the words, "Against the issuance of bonds". The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the laws of the State regulating general elections.
