1. Meeting opened with prayer by City Manager.
2. Mayor Jim Waters advised this special meeting was called for the purpose of canvassing returns from Special City Election held on this date, January 9th, 1962, to fill the unexpired term of E. Kurl Shirey, Commissioner, Ward #1, who recently resigned:

Samuel D. Griffin	572 "

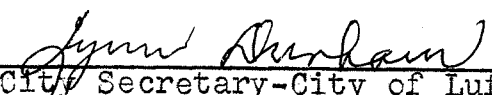
Commissioner A. G. Welch made motion that in as much as Victor V. Bruce received a majority of votes over the combined total of his two opponents, Darrell E. Yates and Samuel D. Griffin, that he be declared the elected Commissioner of Ward #1. Commissioner Beamon S. Cook seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mr. Victor V. Bruce, who was present at the meeting, was congratulated by those in attendance and was advised to report to City Hall at 10:00 AM, January 10, 1962, to receive the Oath of Office and sworn in by City Attorney.
