

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD ON 24th DAY OF MARCH, 1965, AT 9:00 AM

On the 24th day of March, 1965, the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, convened in special meeting in the regular meeting place of said City, with following members thereof, to-wit:

being present, constituting a quorum, when the following business was transacted:

1. Meeting opened with prayer by Mayor Jim Waters.
2. Mayor Waters stated this special meeting was called for the purpose of canvassing the returns of City Bond Election held on March 23, 1965, at Central Fire Station.

Official results showed there were 1830 ballots given out to voters, two of which were unaccounted for and seven were mutilated or defaced. Out of 1821 votes counted, the following returns were reported by Election officials:

"For the issuance of \$125,000 General Obligation Storm Sewer and Drainage Bonds" ..... 1206 votes

"Against the issuance of \$125,000 General Obligation Storm Sewer and Drainage Bonds" ..... 467 votes

Majority for Proposition Number 4 ..... 739 votes

"For the issuance of \$240,000 General Obligation Fire Station Building Bonds" ..... 1112 votes

Majority for Proposition Number 5 ..... 548 votes

"For the issuance of \$280,000 General Obligation City Hall Building Bonds" ..... 979 votes

Majority for Proposition No. 6 ..... 282 votes

"For the issuance of \$150,000 General Obligation Park Bonds" ..... 1038 votes

Majority for Proposition Number 7 ..... 391 votes

Proposition Number 8

"For the issuance of \$65,000 General Obligation Police Station Building Bonds" ..... 1048 votes

"Against the issuance of \$65,000 General Obligation Police Station Building Bonds" ..... 628 votes

Majority for Proposition Number 8 ..... 420 votes

Proposition Number 9


"For the issuance of \$1,500,000 General Obligation Community Center Building Bonds" ..... 948 votes

"Against the issuance of \$1,500,000 General Obligation Community Center Building Bonds" ..... 732 votes


Majority for Proposition Number 9 ..... 216 votes
