It was moved by Largent see by Price all voting unanimously that the following ordinance be passed, placing the following lots and blocks in the brick fire limits of the City of Lufkin; all of Blocks (2) two (3) three (4) four and (9) nine north half of block (10) ten - Lots 19 to 24 in block (10) ten - Lots 13 to 18 in block (8) eight - Lot 6 in block (8) eight - north half of block (16) sixteen - south half of block (8) eight, being lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven & twelve -

An Ordinance.

Be it ordained by the city council of The City of Lufkin that all the blocks numbered two, three, four and nine; the north one-half of block No. ten; lots numbered nineteen, twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three and twenty-four, in block No. ten; lots No. thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen and eighteen in block No. eight; lot No. six in block No. eight; the north one-half of block No. sixteen and the south one-half of block No. eighty as is shown on the map of the City of Lufkin, shall constitute, comprise, and be hereafter known as the "Brick Fire Limits"

Be it further ordained; that it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, or association of persons to erect, construct or build; or cause to be erected, constructed or built, place or cause to be placed, any structures of any kind, other than is described in articles ninety to ninety-eight, inclusive, of chapter sixteen of the ordinance of the City of Lufkin, Texas.

Any person, persons, firm or corporations, or associations of persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon a conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars and each day shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
