Motion by Alderman Taylor, seconded by alderman Glenn, all alderman Voting age that an ordinance be passed and approved, styled.

" An ORDINANCE REGULATING HOTEL PORTERS, RUNNERS, HACK DRIVERS, ETC., when SOLICITING PATRONAGE AT TRAINS; PROVIDING A PENALTY" and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Motion elderman Kerr, seconded by alderman Gibson, all aldermen voting age that an ordinance be passed and approved, styled, "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF LOCOMOTIVES AND TRAINS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES", and the same is nereby passed and approved.

Motion by alderman Gibson, seconded by alderman Fairchild, all alderman voting are that an ordinance be passed and approved, styled, "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND PROHIBITING THE THROWING AND SHOOTING OF STONES, BULLETS, SHOT AND OTHER SUCH MISSILES AT PROPERTY, PERSONS OR ANIMALS AND BIRDS, AND THE SHOOTING OR THROWING ANY SUCH MISSILES ACROSS ANY STREET, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, and PROVIDING PENALTIES", and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Minutes of City of Lufkin, Meeting May 23d., 1914, continued.

Motion by Alderman Kerr, seconded by alderman Fairchild, that an ordinance be passed and approved, styled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE MUZZLING OF VICTOUS DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE ON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, AND PROVIDING PENALTY" -- Vote on this motion stood as follows:

Ayes Kerr, Fairchild, Taylor; Noes, Glenn, Gibson. The ayes prevailed, and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Motion by alderman Glenn, seconded by alderman Taylor, all alderman voting age that an ordinance be passed, styled, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SPIELING, YELLING, LOUD TALKING, AND ADVERTISING OF PICTURE SHOWS CIRCUSES, AND OTHER ATTRACTIONS BY MEANS OF OR THRU MEGAPHONES OR OTHER CONTRIVANCES OR BY ANY OTHER METHOD; PROVIDING FOR PERMITS; PROŽ VIDING PENALTIES", and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Motion by Alderman Taylor, seconded by elderman Glenn, all alderman voting eye that an ordinance be passed and approved, styled, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND DEFINING FIRE LIMITS AND PROVIDING CHARACTER OF MATERIAL TO BE USED IN DRECTING, CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING, REMODELING, OR ROOFING BUILDINGS WITHIN SAID LIMITS; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES", and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Motion by Alderman Kerr, seconded by Alderman Glenn, all alderman voting age, that an ordinance be passed and approved," styled, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PERSONS, EXCEPT THE CITY SCAVENGER, from ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF SCAVENGER WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN WITHOUT OBTAINING A PERMIT; PROVIDING THE METHOD OF GRANTING PERMITS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY," and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Motion by alderman Taylor, seconded by alderman Kerr, all aldermen voting aye, that an ordinance be passed and approved, styled, "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC AND THE USE AND CONDUCT OF ANIMALS IN AND ALONG THE STREETS AND WAYS OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, AND ESTABLISHING RULES OF THE ROAD; PROVIDING PENALTIES.", and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Minutes of the City of Lufkin, Meeting May 23rd., 1914, Continued.

Metion by Fairchild, seconded by Kerr, all aldermon voting type, that

PER Addingues be passed and approved, styled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A

PERALTY FOR FAILURE OR REFUSAL OF PERSONS LIABLE FOR STREET DUTY TO ATTEND

AND WORK STREETS OR FAY IN LIEU THEREOF SUCH SUM OR SUMS AS MAY BE DUE",

and the same is hereby passed and approved.

Report of work done on the streets by U. M. McConnico read showing some good work done within the past ten days, and upon motion of alderman faylor, seconded by alderman Gibson, all alderman voting age, that McConnico be instructed to continue this street work for two more weeks.

Map committee reported advising they would defer the purchasing of a map until next year, but advised the City Engineer co-operate with the Assessor & Collector in assessing taxes for this year in the new City limits. Upon motion being carried this report was adopted.

Communication read from G. T. Cross, Secretary of the Progressive League, showing some statistics as to the financial condition of the City and its assests, from data posessed by his office, making some suggestions and offering their co-operation, and acting upon his suggestion, Mayor Humason appointed as a committee to check up the assets and verify estimated figures furnished aldermen Gibson, Glenn and Fairchild, to report an next meeting of this body.

Motion by alderman Taylor, seconded by alderman Fairchild all aldermen voting age that a resolution be adopted providing for the payment of \$1.00 to the City Marshall for the disposition of dogs, instead of 50¢ as provided for in ordinance dated 9th., day of May 1914, and the same is hereby adopted.

There being no further business a motion was carried to adjourn.
