

(Adjourned meeting)

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met in adjourned session from Sept 4th 1917 on this the 7th day of Sept. 1917 with the following named officers present, K. Morgan mayor presiding & S. W. Hawthorne, W. D. Newsom and W. A. Coon Aldermen and R. P. Walker Secretary.

It is ordered that the mayor check the bills filed by S. W. Henderson for graveling the Street leading out from Lufkin to Kellys and have City warrants issued for same payable out of the general fund of the City. Ordered that D. F. Parker be paid \$5.25 out of the water works operating funds of the City for $1\frac{1}{2}$ days work on the water works system.

It is ordered that the mayor in company with some other business man of the city canvass the city and try to get a liberal contribution from the business men and property owners of the city to help keep up the Fire Department of the city.

There being no further business the Council adjourned subject to the call of the mayor.
