

Lufkin Texas Sept. 10th 1918

The City Council of the City of Lufkin Texas met on this the 10th day of Sept. 1918 with the following

named officers present, to wit,

K. Morgan mayor presiding.

S. W. Hawthorne W. D. Price W. D. Newsom and Chas. L. Bonner, Aldermen, and R. P. Walker Secretary

The object of the meeting as set out in the Mayor call for the Council to meet on this day being to enter into contract with A. G. ^o of

Nacogdoches County Texas to drill a water well for the City of Lufkin Texas whereupon and resolved that K. Morgan, mayor of the city of Lufkin Texas, enter into contract with the said

A. G. Lesterfelt of the County of Nacogdoches Texas to drill a water well on the property of the city of Lufkin said property being situated in Angelina County Texas about $2\frac{1}{2}$, or 3 miles North of the City of Lufkin.

Said well to be drilled within 300 feet of the well the city is now using which was drilled by Layne & Bowler of Houston Texas a copy of said contract is hereto attached and made a part of these minutes and action of the City Council now in session, as follows,

Moved and seconded that the Mayor and City Attorney investigate the legality of the Depository of the City of Lufkin Texas

Moved and seconded and so ordered that that the resignation of E. A. Perkins as water Commissioner be accepted as soon as the Mayor and water Committee can check up his book kept of ^{him} water Commissioner and that the Mayor take charge of the water works of the City of Lufkin Texas and attend to the business of the water Commissioners office till water Commissioner is duly appointed by the Mayor and City Council. And the Mayor is to receive \$100. ⁰⁰ month for his services while acting and serving as water Commissioner

There being no further business to attend to at this meeting the Council adjourned
