

Lupton, Texas, August 28, 1893.

Called Session of the Board of Aldermen of
the Town of Lupton Texas.

and Aldermen Butler, Ballou & Medford.

The name of W. A. Abney was put in nomination
as alderman to fill the vacancy caused
by election of B. L. McPherson to the office of Mayor
and upon motion he was unanimously
elected.

W. A. Abney was then administered the
oath of office as required by law, and took
his seat as Alderman, vice B. L. McPherson, Acting
Mayor.

Population of the Town of Lupton, as known
from examination of the tax rolls of said town, found
to aggregate 827.
