

MINUTES OF CALLED MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS,
HELD DEC. 19th, 1922.

Be it remembered that on this the 19th day of December, 1922, there was begun and holden a called meeting of the City Commission of the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City: present and presiding the Hon. G. A. Kelley, Mayor, S. R. Parker, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, E. E. Woods, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 and B. L. Zeagler, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, and C. N. Humason, City Manager, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The mayor, G.A. Kelley, stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss and determine whether or not the City of Lufkin would accept the verdict of a jury rendered in the trial of condemnation proceedings in the case of opening or the attempting of opening the Railroad property for the purpose of connecting Dozier Avenue and Frank Avenue.

After due consideration and deliberation of said matter it was moved by E.E. Woods and seconded by S.R. Parker that the city of Lufkin refuse to accept the verdict of said jury, and to appeal said cause to the County Court. Said motion carried unanimously.

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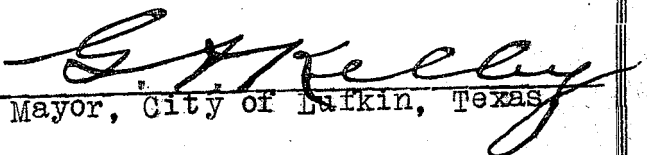
The question of instigating condemnation proceedings against the old East Texas Depot was discussed by the City Commission, after which it was moved by S.R. Parker and seconded by B.L. Zeagler, that the City Manager make investigation of the condition of said depot and to make report to this commission at its next regular meeting. Said motion carried.

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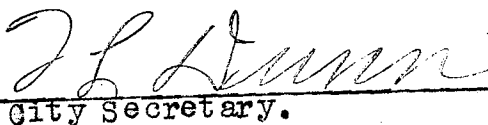
T. There being no further business to come before the meeting, by move and second duly made and carried, adjournment/ was taken.
