W. Hawkins, Mayor, Ace C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, E. W. Leach, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, C. N. Humason, City Manager and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:- W.A.Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3 was absent.

The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the matter of constructing a sewer lineon Kiln Avenue. I.D. Fairchild being one of the interested parties appeared before the City Commission and ask that such sewer be constructed and was informed that if the money necessary to pay the cast of such sewer would be furnished to the city without interest same would be constructed, payment of the money by the city to such party or parties advancing same to be paid in three equal annual payments after such time as revenue from such line would equal 8% on the cost of same. Mr. Fairchild stated that he would see what c uld be done and report later. Therefore, no finel action was taken in the matter.
