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MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD Jan. 6th,
1925.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of January, A. D. 1925,
there came on and was held a regular meeting of the Honorable City Com-
mission of the City of Lufkin, in the City Hall of said City, there being

torney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings

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Minutes of former meetings read, and by move and second duly made
and carried, were adopted as read.

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Mayor, Sam H. Kerr, appointed a committee composed of K. Hoskins,
C. F. Becker and C. N. Humason, to confer with owners of property ad-
joining the City Reservoir for the purpose of ^{negotiating for} purchasing such acreage
as will be required for additional reservoir purposes, and to make pur-
chase of such land if satisfactory price can be agreed upon.
