MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD APRIL 21, 1925.

Be it remembered that on this the 21st, day of April, A. D. 1925, there came on and was held a call meeting of the Honorable City Commission of the City of Lufkin, in the City Hall of said City, there being present and presiding the following officers:*- Kenneth Hoskins, Mayor and Commissioner of Ward No. 4, Protem, (Mayor J. W. Hawkins being absent), Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Ward No. 2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, C. N. Humason, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The purpose of the meeting was to dispose of the sewer question relative to the location of a site and decide on kind of disposal plant to construct.

It having been made known to the City Commission that Mr. Lester Cammon is the owner of a certain ten acre tract of land about a mile south of the City limits of the City of Lufkin, which would be possibly a good site on which to construct a sewer disposal plant, it was moved by Joe C. Denman and seconded by A. M. Walker that Mr. Canmon becseen relative to securing an option for 60 days on said tract of land with the view of purchasing same at a price of \$1,000.00. The motion carried unanimously and City Manager C.N. Humas on and Commissioner Joe C. Denman were appointed to see Mr Cannon at once and if possible to secure the option as aforesaid.

The question came up for discussion as to what type of sewer disposal plant should be constructed. After duly considering the proposition it was moved by W. A. Behannon and seconded by A. M. Walker that the city build an Imhoff sewer tank and sludge beds on the Lester Canon tract if same can be secured and provided such a plant will meet the approval of the State Sanitary Engineer. Motion carried unanimously.

The City manager having recommended to the City Commission that a 12" water main be constructed from the present pumping plant to the new well, it was moved by Commissioner A. M. Walker and Seconded by Commissioner W. A. Behannon, that such a line be constructed as outlined by the City Manager. Metion carried unanimoulsy.

Came up for discussion the question of discontinuing the services of Raymond H. White as City Pound Master. After duly considering said question it was moved by Commissioner A. M. Walker and seconded By Commissioner W. A. Behannon, that the City Manager notify Mr. White that his services as Pound Master as aforesaid be discontinued on the 1st day of May, 1925. Motion carried unanimously.
