

MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN,
TEXAS, HELD AUG. 24th. 1926.

Be it remembered that on this the 24th. day of August, A. D. 1926,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the municipal office there of in said city;
Present and presiding the Hon. J.W.Hawkins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Com-
missioner of Precinct No. 1, A. M. Walker, Commissioner of Precinct No.
2, W. A. Behannon, Commissioner of Ward No. 3, E. W. Leach, Commissioner
of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager, W. O. Seale, City Manager,
and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the following proceedings were
had, to-wit:-

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The Mayor stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss
the question of paving a small part of Mantooth Avenue, (a distance
of some 25 or 30 feet, westward from Raguet Street), and any other
business that might properly come before the meeting.

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Mayor J. W. Hawkins stated that he had some important business
to transact and asked to be excused. He was excused and W. A. Behannon,
the duly selected Mayor protem presided the remainder of the meeting.

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After discussing the matter of paving a little part of Mantooth
Avenue, it was moved by A. M. Walker and seconded by Joe C. Denman,

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that no part of Mantooth Avenue be paved until the entire distance from
at lead on Black western
Raguet Street to Bynum Street is paved. The motion carried unanimously.

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The question of topping with asphalt Zeagler Avenue and that portion of S. Raguet Street between Zeagler Avenue and Kerr Avenue was had, after which on motion made by E. W. Leach and seconded by Joe C. Denman, it was unanimously carried that such topping be done provided the property owners abutting on said streets shall pay in advance two-thirds of the entire cost of such pavement fronting on said streets.

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An ordinance entitled "An Ordinance amending Section 7, Being a prohibited Zone, of an Ordinance regulating motor vehicles of Date December 1st, 1925; Also amending section 12 of said ordinance reducing the minimum penalty to two dollars; and also amending the penalty by reducing same by a minimum of two dollars of Motor vehicle ordinance of date July 17, 1923" was presented for passage and approval, and after due consideration of same it was moved by Commissioner E. W. Leach and seconded by Commissioner A. M. Walker that said ordinance be placed on first reading and passed and approved on such first reading. The Mayor put the question and requested all members of the City Commission who favored the said motion and the passage of said ordinance as aforesaid to vote "aye" and those opposed to vote "no". The following members voted "aye" W. A. Behannon, Joe C. Denman, A. M. Walker and E. W. Leach. The mayor declared the motion carried and the said ordinance passed and approved on first reading.

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On motion made by Joe C. Denman and seconded by E. W. Leach it was unanimously carried that the old Electric Motor at the City Water works plant be sold at a price of \$350.00.

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It was moved by E. W. Leach and seconded by Joe C. Denman that an ordinance amending the ordinance about placing signs on Telegraph and Telephone poles be prepared by the City Attorney so as to make it a violation of law to tie, or in any way place any character of sign on such poles. Motion carried unanimously.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
