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MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS
HELD NOV. 6th, A. D. 1928.

Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of November, A.D. 1928,
there was begun and holden a regular meeting of the City Commission of
the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office thereof in said City,
with the following officers present and presiding, to-wit: J. W. Haw-
kins, Mayor, Joe C. Denman, Commissioner of Ward No. 1, C. A. Burke,
Commissioner of Ward No. 2, M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No. 3,
W. A. Abney, Commissioner of Ward No. 4, V. R. Smitham, City Manager,
W. O. Seale, City Attorney and T. L. Dunn, City Secretary, when the
following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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Minutes of former meetings read, and on motion duly made and car-
ried were approved as read.

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W. F. Athey et als, residents along Lufkin Avenue east from fourth
Street appeared before the City Commission and requested that same be
paved from 4th street to Shepherd Avenue. The matter was discussed,
but because of the fact that the city did not have funds available to
pay for its part of the cost of paving same, it was decided that said
portion of said street could not be paved.

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Bids having been called for to be received and opened at this
meeting of the City Commission for the Construction of a Garbage In-
cinerator, the following bids were received, to-wit:-

Said bids were received and filed for study and consideration,
and V. R. Smitham, City Manager and M. C. Spivey, Commissioner of Ward No.
3 and C. A. Burke, Commissioner of Ward No. 2 were appointed as a com-
mittee to study said bids and make recommendation as to the one to
be accepted.

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All bills and accounts due by the city to various parties, firms and corporations were presented for payment, and it appearing that such of said bills as had been properly audited and allowed by the City Manager, on motion duly made and carried same were allowed, and the City Secretary instructed to draw City warrants in payment of same.

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On motion made by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney it was unanimously carried that the paving on the following streets and avenues be accepted as final:-

Lufkin Avenue from the West line of Third Street to the East line of fourth street;

Rhodes Avenue from the E line of North 1st street to the West line of North Second Street;

Bremond Avenue from the East Line of North Angelina Avenue to the West line of North Third Street.

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E. J. Conn appeared and asked that a gas franchise be granted to a local company on the same conditions and at the same rates as those demanded by the Dixie Gas & Fuel Company. He proposed to post a bond in the amount of \$20,000.00, guaranteeing to furnish gas in a specified time. After discussing the question it was unanimously decided to refuse to grant such a franchise.

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Whereas, heretofore on October 24 it was unanimously voted to award the contract for the construction of a fire station to Campbell & White, at the same price they bid under date of January 24th, A.D. 1928, which price is the sum of \$21,557.00. Now, on motion duly made by M.C. Spivey and seconded by C. A. Burke it was unanimously carried that an ordinance be passed on first reading authorizing the mayor to execute contract with said Campbell & White for the construction of the firestation as aforesaid, and appropriating funds sufficient to pay for the construction of same.

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There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.

OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN HELD NOVEMBER 6th, A. D. 1928.


Be it remembered that on this the 6th day of November A. It appearing to the City Commission that that portion of one Avenue, viz:

(a) Lufkin Avenue from its intersection with the west line of Third Street to its intersection with the west line of Fourth Street; has been completed according to contract for street paving with Scott Shambaugh of Houston, Texas, of date June 8th, A. D. 1928, and the acceptance of said avenue has been recommended in writing by City Engineer and City Manager, Mr. V. R. Smitham; on motion M. C. Spivey, seconded by C. A. Burke, all voting yea, said avenue was accepted from Scott Shambaugh, paving contractor, and said improvement on said avenue is now received and accepted by the City.

The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to issue improvement assessment certificates therefor in accordance with the assessments ordinance heretofore passed, a form of said assessment certificates has heretofore been approved for use in the present paving program, which is in all respects approved.
