The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The parpose of the Meeting was to call an election for the election of a City Commissioner from Ward No. 3, R. C. Jordan, the duly elected Commissioner from said beat having died thereby creating a vacancy in said office, and to do and perform any other business that might properly come before the meeting.

An ordinance calling said election was duly presented and on motion made by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney, same was passed by the following vote, which is here recorded, to-wit:- "AYES"- Wm. A. Foster, W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke and W. A. Abney "NOTS"- None. Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approveed. (See another page of these minutes for a record of said ordinance)

The City Commission having called for prices or bids from the Class Motor Company for the purchase of a Ford tw-odoor sedan and from the C.L. DuBuy Chevrolet Company for a two-door Chevrolet sedan, same were received and opened, and after considering samh of them, it was moved by W. O. Greene and seconded by C. A. Burke, that the proposal of the Class Motor Company to sell the City & Ford be accepted, to be paid for in three equal monthly installment of 1110.00 each without interest, a credit of \$288.00 mbeing allowed on the old Ford the city owned. The mothin carried unsnimoulsy

There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion duly made and carried same adjourned.
