MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING
OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD
December 21st, 1931.

-- Be it remembered that on this the 21st day of December, A.D. 1931,
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the
City of Lufkin, Texas, at the City Hall in said City, with the following
officers of the City present, to-wit:-

Wm. A. Foster,	Mayor,
W. O. Greene,	Coms. Ward No. 1
C. A. Burke,	Coms. Ward No. 2
W. A. Abney,	Coms. Ward No. 4
R. C. Musslewhite,	City Attorney, and
T. L. Dunn,	City Secretary, and Acting City Manager.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

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The purpose of the Meeting was to call an election for the election
of a City Commissioner from Ward No. 3, R. C. Jordan, the duly elected
Commissioner from said beat having died thereby creating a vacancy in
said office, and to do and perform any other business that might prop-
erly come before the meeting.

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An ordinance calling said election was duly presented and on motion
made by C. A. Burke and seconded by W. A. Abney, same was passed by the
following vote, which is here recorded, to-wit:- "AYES"- Wm. A. Foster,
W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke and W. A. Abney. "NOES"- None. Thereupon the
Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and approved.

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The City Commission having called for prices or bids from the Glass
Motor Company for the purchase of a Ford tw-door sedan and from the
C.L. DuBuy Chevrolet company for a two-door Chevrolet sedan, same were
received and opened, and after considering same of them, it was moved
by W. O. Greene and seconded by C. A. Burke,
that the proposal of the Glass Motor Company to sell the City a Ford be
accepted, to be paid for in three equal monthly installment of \$110.00
each without interest, a credit of \$288.00 being allowed on the old Ford
the City owned. The motion carried unanimously

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There being no further business to come before the meeting on motion
duly made and carried same adjourned.
