It appearing to the Town Council of
the town of ~~Lufkin~~ that the Marshall
J. B. McCalinico has made his re-
port of the surveys of the said town
of Lufkin and it appearing to
the Council that said town and
Corporate limits of the said town

of Lufkin contains over one thousand inhabitants with in the incorporated limits of said town.

It is therefore ordered by the town Council of the town of Lufkin that a vote of the City Council of the town of Lufkin be taken to determine whether or not the said incorporation of the town of Lufkin shall accept the provisions of Title 18 Chapter 10 ^{inclusive} of the Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas of 1893 in lieu of Chapter 11 of Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas of 1893.

It is ordered by the town Council of the town of Lufkin that as many as favor the adoption of Title 18 including Chapter one to Ten inclusive of the Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas of 1893 in lieu of Chapter eleven Title 18 of Revised Statutes of the State of Texas of 1893 will vote Yes, and as many as are opposed to its adoption will vote No and a vote having been taken resulted as follows
 W. H. Barnes voted Yes W. M. James voted Yes J. H. [unclear] voted Yes
 A. H. [unclear] voted No. It therefore appearing to the town Council

of said town of Sulphur that
 Title 18 Chapters from one to ten
 inclusive of Revised ^{Civil} Statutes of
 the State of Texas have been
 adopted in lieu of Chapter
 Eleven of same laws by a
 two-thirds vote of the said
 town Council.

It is therefore ordered by the
 town Council of the town of
 Sulphur at a regular meeting
 that Title Eighteen of Chapter
 one to ten inclusive of the re-
 vised Statutes of the State of
 Texas, as revised in 1893 be
 and the same is hereby adop-
 ted in lieu of Chapter Eleven
 of same ~~laws~~, and that
 a certified copy of the proceedings
 of this meeting and action of the
 town Council pertaining to the adop-
 tion of said chapters from one to
 ten inclusive of title Eighteen be
~~and~~ attested with the signature
 of the mayor and attested by the
 secretary of said town Council
 with the seal of said Corporation to
 appear to be filed and recorded in
 the office of the County Clerk of
 Angelina County Texas
