MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF
THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
LUFKIN, TEXAS? HELD NOV. 27th
1933.

Be it remembered that on this the 27th day of November, A. D. 1933
there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission of the City
of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following
officers of the City present and presiding, tow-it:-

W. A. Foster,	Mayor.
C. A. Burke,	Coms. Ward No. 2,
D. A. Campbell,	Coms. Ward No. 3,
W. A. Abney,	Coms. Ward No. 4,
R.C. Musslewhite,	City Attorney, and
F. L. Dunn,	City Secretary, and Acting City Manager.

W. O. Greene, Commissioner of Ward No. 1 was absent.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The question of making provision for connecting Highway No. 40
from Raguet Street to S. First Street through property of J.E. Wilson
was discussed. Mr. Wilson was present and was asked on what terms he would
be willing to give permission to make such connection by passing over his
property. He stated that he would want \$7,500.00 cash, and the moving of
three houses, the moving of such houses to be at City Expense. He was asked
what he would expect to extend Highway 40 on North Raguet adjacent to
some property he owns there. He stated that such property consisted of
three houses and lots, and would take \$1200. for the whole. The matter
was taken under advisement; no action taken.

The question of making application to the PWA for funds to install
Sanitary toilets was discussed, after which it was decided that such ap-
plication be made.

The City Attorney was instructed to settle suits pending against the
City by A.E. Grager and J.C. Alee to the best interests of the City, a limit
being given him.

A representative from the State Health Department was present and
promised full co-operation in the carrying out of the program of Malaria
Control, Pit Toilet Construction under the CWA program now under way
in the County and City.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on
motion duly made and carried, it adjourned.
