The question of making provision for connecting Highway No. 40 from Raguet Street to S. First Street through property of J.E.Wilson was discussed. Mr. Wilson was present and was asked on what terms he would be willing to give permission to make such connection by passing over his property. He stated that he would want \$7,500.00 cash, and the moving of three houses, the moving of such houses to be at City Expense. He was asked what he would expect to extend Highway 40 on North Ragaat adjacent to some property he owns there. He stated that such property consideed of three houses and lots, and would take \$1200. for the whole. The matter was taken under advisement; no action taken.
