MINUTES OF A CALL MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LUFKIN, TEXAS, HELD JAN. 17th, 1933.

- Be it remembered that on this the 17th day of January, A.D. 1953, - there was begun and holden a call meeting of the City Commission in and for the City of Lufkin, Texas, at the Municipal Office in said City with the following officers of the City present and presiding:-

Mayor, Wm. A. Foster, Coms. Ward No. W. O. Greene, C. A. Burke, Coms. Ward No. Coms. Ward No. 3, Jones, M. M. Coms. Ward No. W. A. Abney, City Attorney, R. C. Musslewhite, and L. Dunn, City Secretary, and Acting City Manager.

The following proceedings were had, to-wit:-

The meeting was walled for the purpose of discussing the matter of connecting the City Pavement on Highway No. 94, same being Elliss Ave. with said Highway No. 94, as same is now being paved by the State. It being the desire of the City to have such connection made in order that there would be no skip or leave out between the city's pavement and the state's finishehighway.

The matter above referred to was thoroughly discussed, after which it was decided to take the matter up with the Commissioners Court with the idea of having a joint meeting about the matter, and for both the County and City to decide on what steps to take and that said City and County would proceed along the same lines. City Manager was instructed to get in touch with the County Judge and arrange for such joint meeting. ---000---

A petition signed by more-than 200 persons, patrons of the local telephone exchange waying for a reduction in telephone rates was presented by Mr. J.N. Shofner, one of the petitioners. The petition was examined and discussed, and it being ascertained that the telephone company had not been approached on the subject of reducing their rates, it was decided to write them, advisig them of such petition and asking them for a letter expressing their attitute regarding same, which such letter was to be in the hands of the City Commission for consideration at its regular meeting February 7th, 1933 at 7:30 P.M.

The matter of selling the mule team and wagon was discussed. It was ordered that sale of same be made.
