~~Art 37~~ Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Lufkin Texas
 Art 37 that it shall be the duty of each person liable to work on the streets alleys squares and highways of this city to perform his duties as such, as required by law and to do a reasonable amount of work and in accordance with the directions of the marshal

~~Art 38~~ Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Lufkin Texas
 Art 38 that no person shall be compelled to work on the streets alleys squares and highways of the city of Lufkin more than five days in each year

~~Art 39~~ Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Lufkin Texas
 Art 39 that if any person liable under the ordinances of this town to work upon the streets alleys squares and highways within the city of Lufkin shall wilfully fail or refuse to attend either in person or by

Substitute at the time and place designated by the City Marshal of said City of Lufkin, after being lawfully summoned or shall fail on or before the day for which he is summoned to attend, to pay to such Marshal the sum of one dollar per day for each he may have been notified to work on the streets, Alleys, Squares and Highways, or having attended shall fail to perform any duty required of him by the ordinances and such Marshal shall be fined in any sum not less than five, nor more than ten dollars for each day he may so fail and refuse to perform such work as law and part of laws in conflict with this is hereby provided.
